Who is collecting my data?

The 'data controller' is the Secretary of Holmwood Park Residents Association (HPRA) who can be contacted at:

What of my data is being collected and how is it used?

We collect your names and your contact details. We ask for your contact details so we can send you details of meetings, working parties and information relating to estate matters, ie 'In The Know' and other informal notifications of interest. If you do not want us to contact you, you can say so.

Who will my data be shared with?

We will not share your information with others without your specific consent, such as the organiser of the Bat Walks for convenience purposes.

If you are relying on my consent to process my data, can I withdraw my consent?

You have the right to withdraw consent at any time, where processing is based on your consent.

How long will my data be held for?

The HPRA Committee agreed that we will hold this data for the current membership year and a further 2 years.

What will happen if I don't provide the data?

If you don't provide this information we won't be able to inform you of issues pertaining to HPRA.

Will my data be used for automated decision-making or profiling?

The provision of the information you provide is not connected with individual decision making (making a decision solely by automated means without any human involvement) or profiling (automated processing of personal data to evaluate certain things about an individual).

Will my data be transferred outside of the UK? If it will, how will it be protected?

The data you provide will not be transferred outside the United Kingdom.
